The 'Little Book of Keyboard Pieces' which Johann Sebastian Bach compiled in 1725 for his second wife, Anna Magdalena, consists largely of music by composers other than himself. One of them is this Menuet (originally one of a pair), long attributed to Bach, but now known to be a movement from a suite by the Dresden organist Christian Pezold (1677–1733).
